

## Travel Information / 2009 UW Graduate Conference for Interdisciplinary Studies

### Directions By Car

FROM THE NORTH: Take I-5 South, take Exit 169 to NE 45th St. Drive east along NE 45th and turn right at Memorial Way (17th Ave NE). Purchase parking pass at attendant's booth and proceed to appropriate parking lot.

FROM THE SOUTH: Take I-5 North, take Exit 169 to NE 45th St. Drive east along NE 45th and turn right at Memorial Way (17th Ave NE). Purchase parking pass at attendant's booth and proceed to appropriate parking lot.

FROM THE EAST: Take I-90 West towards Seattle. Take Exit 2C onto I-5 North. Take Exit 169 to NE 45th St. Drive east along NE 45th and turn right at Memorial Way (17th Ave NE). Purchase parking pass at attendant's booth and proceed to appropriate parking lot.

### Parking Information

Metered street parking is available, though limited on neighborhood streets between 8th Ave NE & University Way NE ("The Ave"), as well as between NE 41st St & NE 43rd St. There are a number of hourly and daily parking lots along NE 45th St. between I-5 and campus. On-Campus parking is available for a fee. Before parking on campus, stop and purchase a parking permit from one of the following conveniently located gatehouses:

- NE 45th St and Memorial Way by the Burke Museum
- the underground Central Plaza Garage at 15th Ave NE and NE 41st St.
- on Stevens Way by Meany Hall
- on Pend Oreille Rd. off of Montlake Ave NE
- directly in front of Husky Stadium off Montlake Blvd. NE
- and in front of the UWMC on Columbia Rd.

At the gatehouses, Traffic Guides will assign a parking location according to your destination. Gatehouses are staffed weekdays from 6 a.m. - 9 p.m. and on Saturdays from 7 a.m. until noon. At the gatehouse ask for disability parking and building access information as needed. Visitors parking is available in the Central Plaza Garage which can be entered from 15th Ave NE at NE 41st St.

**The daily parking fee is \$12/day** between 6 a.m. and 4 p.m. weekdays. Stop at a gatehouse as you exit campus for a prorated refund if you parked on campus for less than 4 hours. An evening rate begins at 4 p.m. and is \$6/evening.

Complimentary parking is available weekday evenings from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Cheaper parking options are available daily in the large E1 lot north of the Husky Stadium off Montlake Blvd. NE. for a \$6 fee. Also self-serve pay stations are located in several west campus lots (W2, W4, W6, W12 and W14); daytime rate is \$3 per hour (maximum 2 hours); or, evenings after 4:00 pm, a flat fee of \$5. Outlying east campus lots E4 and E3 northeast of the E1 lot off Clark Rd. are \$3.00 (exact change only) per day.

### Bus Information

Bus fare: \$1.75 (Off-Peak), \$2.00 (Peak) and includes a 2 ½ hour transfer.

Bus Directions from Airport to U-District:

Follow signs to public transportation at the far end of the baggage claim. Take the Bus 194 (Express) or 174 (Local) to Downtown Switch to the 43 or 49 at 4th Ave and Pike St. OR Switch to 71 at 4th Ave & Jackson St Exit bus at Campus Parkway and Brooklyn Ave.

Bus Directions from Amtrak Station to U-District:

Walk from train station to underground bus terminal at 5th Ave and S Jackson Take the Bus 73 to Cowen Park/Jackson Park Exit bus at Campus Parkway and Brooklyn Ave.
