PROGRAM NOTE

It's always dangerous to read an author's life into his work, but it's hard not to with Odon von Horvath. Before 1933, von Horvath was the licensed wise guy of German theater, cooly exposing the hypocrisy of Weimar-era society. After 1933 and Hitler's rise, he was suddenly an outsider himself, his very acquaintance shunned by his former admirers.

Instead of making him bitter, the experience made him think about his own former cynical detachment. Figaro Gets a Divorce, his last completed play, embodies that thinking: rueful, realistic, yet somehow deeply optimistic about the odds of decency surviv a world gone mad.
