

SERVICES REQUEST TIMELINE

In order to ensure sufficient time to make provisions for appropriate accommodations and auxiliary aid(s), students must request approved accommodations in a timely manner, through myDRS, unless otherwise noted. Below is a list of services and appropriate timelines for most circumstances.

If a request is submitted after the relevant deadline, DRS will make every reasonable effort to accommodate the request but cannot guarantee that such a request can be met. Accommodations are approved throughout the quarter, but are not retroactive.

Untimely requests may result in delay, substitutions, or the inability to fulfill the request(s).

TYPE OF SERVICE	TIME REQUIRED			
Accessible Instructional Materials	Requests for <i>non-STEM text-to-speech conversion</i> and <i>image file conversion</i> are due at least 4 weeks prior to the first day of class.			
	Requests for <i>all other</i> accessible instructional materials are due at least 6 weeks prior to the first day of class.			
Classroom Services	Requests for classroom services (Classroom Relocation, Accommodation Furniture, Scribes, Lab Assistants, etc.) are due at least 4 weeks prior to the first day of class.			
Communication Access	Requests for <u>communication access services</u> (Real-Time Translation, ASL Interpreters, Video Captioning, etc.) are made through myDRS. Recurring classroom and multi-day event requests are due at least 5 weeks in advance. Requests for one-time events and meetings are due at least 10 days in advance.			
Clinicals, Clerkships, Practicums, Externships, Internships, etc.	Accommodations for non-classroom activities must be discussed as soon as possible with your DRS Coordinator, since accommodations at these sites can require a multi-department effort.			
Disability-Related Absences Agreement	For each class, complete a <i><u>Disability-Related Absences Agreement</u></i> with your instructor (through myDRS), before the end of the second week of the quarter .			
Exam Accommodations	For each class, complete an <u>Alternative Testing Agreement</u> with your instructor (through myDRS), as soon as possible. Then, schedule non-final exams at least 5 business days in advance, and final exams 10 or more business days in advance. Please visit the DRS Testing Center web page for more information.			
Foreign Language Requirement Substitution	Foreign language substitutions should be requested as soon as possible , as multiple departments work together and need sufficient time to process requests. Please visit the DRS <u>Foreign Language Requirement</u> web page for more information.			
Hardship Withdrawal Petition	Petitions are due within one year of the quarter being appealed. Please visit the UW <u>Hardship Withdrawal</u> web page for more information.			
Housing Accommodations	Requests are due at least 3 months prior to the anticipated move-in date. Please vis the DRS <u>On-Campus Housing</u> web page for more information.			
Notetaking Services	Notetaking services requests are due at least 2 weeks prior to the first day of class.			
Reduced Credit Load - Financial Aid Priority Appeal	Requests for <u>reduced credit load</u> (<i>Priority Appeal Reduced Credit Load Requests</i>) are due at least 4 weeks prior to the first day of class.			
Study Abroad	Accommodation requests are due in writing at least 8 weeks prior to the departure date.			
Tuition Forfeiture Petition	Petitions are due within one year of the quarter being petitioned. Please visit the <u>Tuition Forfeiture page</u> on the UW website for more information.
