David K.P. Li is Chairman and Chief Executive of The Bank of East Asia, which was established in Hong Kong in 1918. Dr. Li is a Member of the Executive Council and the Legislative Council of Hong Kong. He is a Member of the Banking Advisory Committee, Hong Kong Association of Banks (Executive Committee), Pacific Rim Bankers Program Advisory Board, and Chairman of the Chinese Banks' Association.

Dr. Li attended the University of Cambridge, and has an MA in Economics and Law and an Honorary Degree of Doctor of Law conferred by the University in June 1993. The University of Warwick conferred the Honorary Degree of Doctor of Law on Dr. Li in July 1994. In March 1996, the University of Hong Kong conferred on Dr. Li the Honorary Degree of Doctor of Law. In November 1996, the Lingnan College conferred on Dr. Li the Honorary Degree of Doctor of Social Sciences. In May 2002, Trinity College in Hartford, Connecticut, conferred on Dr. Li the Honorary Degree of Doctor of Humane Letters.

He is a Fellow of The Chartered Institute of Bankers, of the Institute of Chartered Accountants in England and Wales, and of the Australian Society of Certified Practising Accountants.
