Therapy Services

We are here to help children, youth and adults after a trauma. Sometimes survivors and family members need information and support. Other times, it helps to talk about the impact of trauma and see if counseling would help. HATC offers free initial appointments to help determine the level of support our patients need. HATC also provides effective therapies that help people recover from the impact of trauma.



Advocacy & Support Services

Our advocates are here to help with free, confidential services. Our free services include crisis assistance, support, medical and legal advocacy, brief supportive counseling, information, and referral. We can meet with people in our office, in the community, on the phone, or through Zoom.

Foster Care Assessment Program

The Foster Care Assessment Program (FCAP) is a statewide program contracted by the Department of Children, Youth and Families (DCYF) for dependent children. FCAP provides consultations and assessments for the most complex cases in the child welfare system.

Medical Services

Medical care is an important part of the recovery process. After an assault, an individual has the right to receive a medical exam and treatment at no cost. If appropriate, forensic evidence can also be collected during this exam (if seen within 120 hours), by a specially trained provider. We can help determine the appropriate location to receive this exam based on age, location, and time since the assault. More resources can be found at wasafe.org.

Prevention Services

Harborview provides prevention services in an effort to change systems, social norms, attitudes and behaviors that lead to violence. Our prevention activities and initiatives include comprehensive sexual health education, policy work, trainings, and more.



To Request Services

Help is available 24 hours a day by calling the Harborview Abuse & Trauma Center. Our main office hours are 8:30 AM – 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday. On nights and weekends, please ask for the Emergency Department social worker. We provide interpreters in over 50 languages. Most of our services are free.
