The Stim as'pus project, or What's in Your Heart? project, resulted from an eight year collaboration with the Colville Tribes. This presentation will discuss the cultural adaptation efforts of an evidence-based parenting skills curriculum. It will provide an overview of the cultural fit and perceptions of the curriculum. Attendees of this presentation will gain an understanding of the need for cultural adaptation of evidence-based interventions, be able to explain the cultural adaptation approach for implementing these evidenced-based approaches, and understand how the diverse perspectives from the tribal community inform parenting skills development.
