Their research team has identified gaps and brainstormed 'fixes' to support victims with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD) in reporting sexual assaults. They connected with professionals (e.g., law enforcement, victim advocates), individuals with IDD, and the community (e.g., caregivers, support persons). During this workshop, they will discuss barriers to communication, current policy and available accommodations including tools to support individuals with IDD, and areas for training. This work is foundational to support individuals with IDD to report victimization.
