AD HOC HONORS DEGREE

Petition for right to complete an *ad hoc* Honors degree

College and Departmental Honors students at the University of Washington may petition to complete an *ad hoc* Honors degree if they are majors in a department without an approved departmental Honors program. The completed petition should be submitted to the Honors office at least two quarters prior to graduation after consultation with a University Honors Program adviser, the departmental adviser, and a faculty mentor. Typically, an *ad hoc* Honors degree plan will include ten or more credits of advanced course work taken for *ad hoc* Honors credit and a significant directed research and writing project.
