UW Animal Research and Care Facility [ARCF]

You are invited to an informal open house where we will be providing some general information regarding the upcoming construction of the new UW Animal Research and Care Facility (ARCF). The ARCF will be a new, two story, 85,000 square foot, animal research facility, to be constructed below grade, beneath the Portage Bay Vista on the UW Seattle Campus. At the open house, representatives from the Capital Projects Office, Health Sciences Administration and the design and construction team will be providing a general overview of the project, discuss the current schedule assumptions and describe the proposed site logistics during construction, including: location of construction trailers and contractor parking, pedestrian detours around the construction site and other construction activities that may impact the surrounding community. This will be the first of several open house meetings we are planning leading up to the start of construction and continuing throughout the course of the construction.
