

Hospitalist Opportunities in Maine

Coastal Maine:

Southern Maine Medical Center, a 150-bed in the southern Maine coastal town of Biddeford, needs another Hospitalist to join the full time service. Schedule is one week off per month, with rotating days and nights the rest of the month. Daily census is 18-22 patients. This hospital is training site for a local medical school. Located 30-minutes from Portland and 2 hours from Boston, this area has immediate access to the rocky coastline, yet features miles of rolling hills.

Mid Coast Hospital, a 74-bed hospital in Brunswick serving a population of over 90,000, is looking for a full time Hospitalist. Daily census averages 18 patients. Schedule is mixed with 1 week off every 4 or 5. Mid Coast was built in 2001 on 150 acres of beautifully wooded land in Brunswick. Building and service expansions are underway on the campus. Brunswick is home to Bowdoin College, an excellent liberal arts private college. The area is 30-minutes north of Portland and just minutes from the coast.

Miles Memorial Hospital, in the mid-coast community of Damariscotta is seeking a 4th Hospitalist for its' expanding service. This is a 38-bed hospital serving a coastal community of 10,000 in the winter and 30,000 in the summer. Damariscotta is both a working fishing village and a tourist destination.

Penobscot Bay Medical Center, a 79-bed community hospital in the gorgeous seaside community of Camden/Rockport, is seeking a 5th hospitalist. The hospital services a community of 50,000 residents. This is one of the most desirable locations in Maine, with a topnotch medical staff who have chosen the coast of Maine for the recreational options and relaxed lifestyle.

Waldo County General Hospital, is a 25-bed critical access hospital seeking a full time, daytime hospitalist. Two physicians provide 7 day coverage, from 6 am to 6 p.m. The remainder of the time is covered by experienced mid-level practitioners. Belfast is a beautiful waterfront town of 7,000. The hospital serves a community of 37,000. It is located 45 minutes from Augusta, the State's Capitol.

City Hospitalist positions:

Mercy Hospital, in Maine's largest city of Portland is seeking a full time Hospitalist. This is a 230-bed hospital with an established Hospitalist Service seeking its' 8th member. A typical schedule is 7-8, 10 hour shifts per two week cycle. Call is once a week from home. You also work one shift every third weekend. There may be schedule changes as the team expands. Portland consistently rates as one of the best small cities along the east coast. It is a vibrant city with theater, symphony, galleries and sports. It has more restaurants per capita than any city of its' size. It is minutes from beautiful sandy coastal beaches, and an hour from the ski resorts. Portland is also home to a large campus of the University of Maine.

St. Joseph Hospital, a 130-bed community hospital, was the first hospital in the State to develop a hospitalist program 15 years ago. The hospital is looking for a 7th physician. They employ a block schedule. Bangor is Maine's second largest city and is minutes away from the University of Maine's flagship campus in Orono. The city has many gracious old neighborhoods along with a lot of new development. The community boasts a symphony, performing arts center, a state of the art children's museum, and the American Folk Festival. There are many lakes and mountains nearby. It is 1½ hours from Acadia National Park.

There are several other opportunities around the State. A few are eligible to sponsor a J-1 or H1-B waiver. Salaries are competitive, typically starting at around \$180K and many will offer assistance with medical education debt. A full fringe benefits package is provided along with paid CME, moving allowance and paid interview expenses.
