Deadline for fellowship applications

The UW application submission deadline is January 1 of the year preceding start of fellowship. Interviews are scheduled between February and May. Positions are filled through the National Resident Matching Program (NRMP). Applicants should review the Cardiology fellowship website: <http://depts.washington.edu/cardweb/fellowship/index.shtml>

Suggested curriculum during residency

Faculty mentorship is essential to:

- a. Establish contacts within the Cardiology Division to explore clinical interests
- b. Pursue mentored research opportunities

Recommended clinical and research experience:

- a. Critical care/Medical ICU
- b. Hospitalist inpatient medicine
- c. Pulmonary consultation
- d. General medicine consultation (pre-op evaluation)
- e. Nephrology consultation
- f. Hematology consultation
- g. Emergency medicine
- h. Geriatric care
- i. Sports Medicine
- j. Ambulatory block experience in
 - Hypertension (UW subspecialty clinic)
 - Diabetes Care Center (Roosevelt clinic)
 - Lipid management (UW subspecialty clinic)
- k. Mentored Research with exposure to methodology, approach and critical review.

Completion of Cardiology consultation or CCU months in addition to the standard required rotations is not recommended. Rather, utility of a comprehensive residency education is greater to enrich education/experience in preparation for fellowship training.
