- Send official GRE scores to the University of Washington. Reporting code: 4854. Must be received by February 1.
- Send official TOEFL score to the University of Washington (permanent residents and international applicants only). Reporting Code: 4854. Must be received by February 1.
- Request letters of recommendation

By February 1st submit online:

- 3 Letters of Recommendation
- Statement of Purpose (with name on each page)
- Resume or Curriculum Vitae
- Essay (name and title on each page)
- Unofficial transcript(s) in PDF format
- Pay \$75 non-refundable application fee via credit or debit card

By February 1st submit via postal mail to the Museology Program:

- Official transcripts in sealed envelopes (1 copy from each institution attended).
Must be postmarked by February 1.
