Dr. Molitch has been active in clinical research for many years in diabetes and other areas of endocrinology, including pituitary tumors. He has been a member of the committees that wrote many current clinical guidelines used by endocrinologists including those for Adult Growth Hormone Deficiency, Prolactinomas, Acromegaly, Pituitary Incidentalomas, Diabetes (Standards of Care), and Diabetic Nephropathy. In addition, he is Principal Investigator of the Northwestern Center for several NIHsponsored studies, including the Diabetes Control and Complications Trial (DCCT) and Epidemiology of Diabetes and Its Complications (EDIC) study, the Diabetes Prevention Program Observational Study (DPPOS), the Prevention of Early Renal Loss (PERL) study and the Bypass Angioplasty Revascularization Investigation 2 Diabetes (BARI 2D) study.



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
