#### 1. Bylaw draft for consideration / elections / term-limits

- a. [distributing copies of bylaws]
  - i. Julie: Karla and Brian have been working on union-related guidance in bylaws to try maintain separate entities while keeping things inclusive for all participants.
  - ii. Alex: suggests that language in Article 8, union liaison recusion from executive board decisions could be added to Article 7, mainly to clarify the reasoning behind it, which is that it could cause actual or perceived conflicts-of-interest.
  - iii. Reconsider OPA liason; Julie will redraft
  - iv. Alex update: upcoming meeting today for a job-title meeting and mediation to consider who can be included in the union unit; university would prefer to exclude all of those job titles; university would also like to exclude NSF fellows, given that NSF doesn't pay university overhead (although NYU postdoc organization has a way around it); still an issue with pay raises denials overall.
  - v. Generic clause for conflicts that arise that are not specifically addressed in bylaws to be resolved by distributing decision making across executive committee
