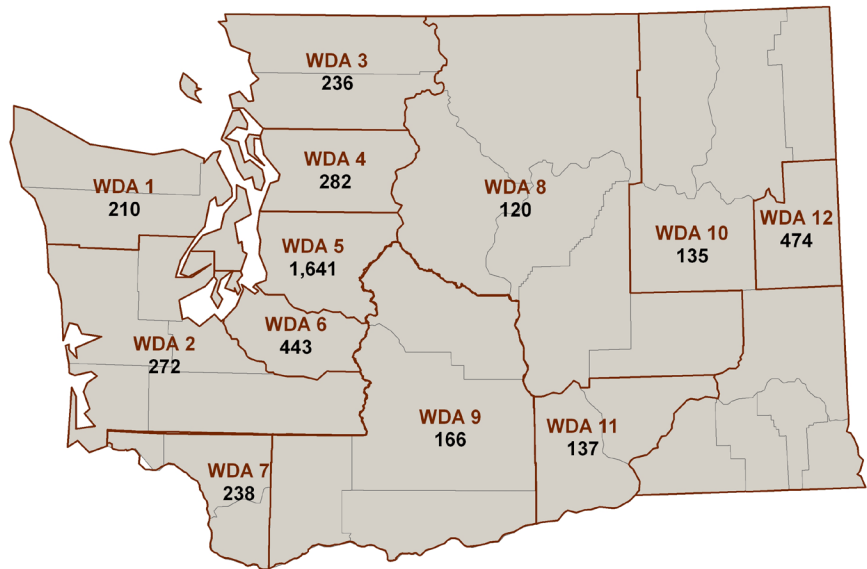




Advanced Registered Nurse Practitioners (ARNPs)

The advanced registered nurse practitioner (ARNP) license category in Washington includes nurse anesthetists, nurse midwives, and nurse practitioners. In Washington State, ARNPs must also hold active registered nurse licenses. The following Washington statistics were calculated based on data from the ARNP license files, which contain licensee name, mailing address, age, and gender.

ARNPs with Washington Licenses by Workforce Development Area (WDA),* 2013



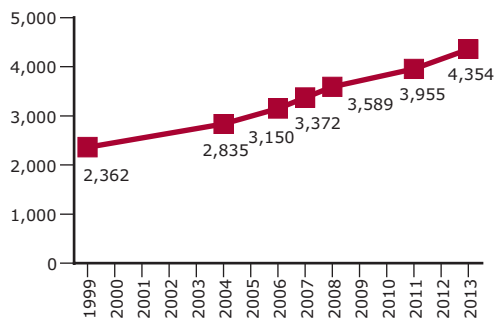

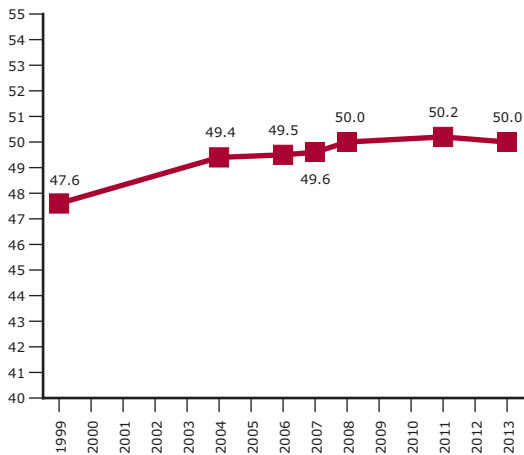

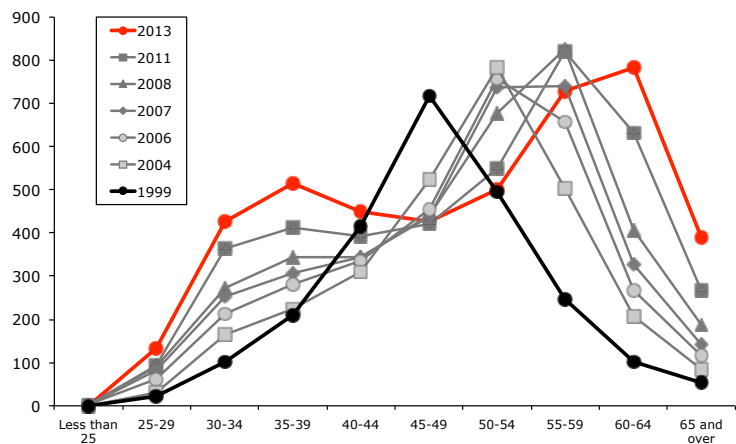

Average Age of ARNPs in Washington

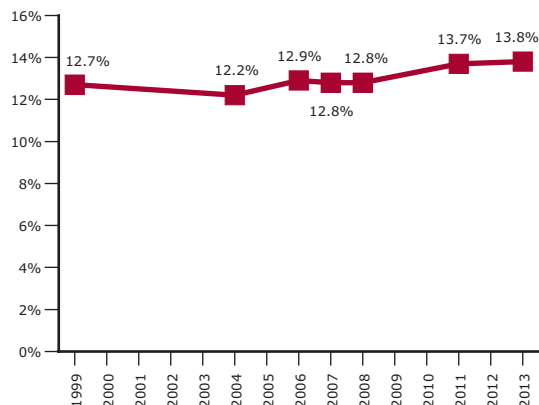


ARNPs with Washington Licenses, by Age Group

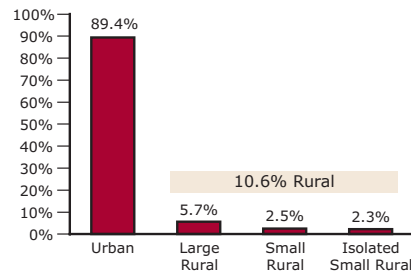


ARNP Gender
