Do you have a graduating high school senior who might be interested in becoming a K-12 teacher? Seattle Central Community College and the University of Washington are partnering to offer the Teachers for New Era program for graduating high school seniors who want to become a teacher. The program provides support such as specific program advising and mentoring, as well as opportunities for full tuition scholarships from Associate in Elementary Ed degree to B.A/Ed minor through Masters in Teaching degree for students who qualify. At Seattle Central a specific scholarship for Teachers of New Era scholarship students has been set up on the Seattle Central foundation website <http://seattlecentral.edu/foundation/scholarships/>. The University of Washington is offering students who qualify the opportunity to apply for the Husky promise scholarship www.huskypromise.washington.edu.

The deadline for to apply for the Seattle Central Teachers for a New Era Foundation scholarship is **April 2nd 2007**. **Students who are applying for the scholarship need to take a placement test at Seattle Central on either March 5th, 6th, 12th or 13th at 4:00 PM.** However students who do not qualify for the scholarship may also apply and pursue the program.
