Luke Rogers discussed his vision for Parcel Framework Standards:

- There are 3 components of Parcel GIS
  - Data Production
  - Data Publication
  - Data Consumption
- FGDC/ESRI data models focus on production
- Need to focus on data publication
- Data publication standard is current need which overtime may evolve into data transfer standard
