MOTORSHIP OREGON DISABLED, TOWS TO HAWAII

Seattle-Built Craft Picked Up off Islands After Losing Battle With Storm.

Drift in a disabled condition as a result of a long battle with heavy gales and huge seas, the Seattle-built motorship Oregon today is being towed into Honolulu by the steamship...

No details as to the plight of the Oregon are given in the dispatches, but it is stated that she has been damaged in heavy weather and has lost her deckload of structural steel. The name of the steamship which went to the assistance of the motorship is withheld by the navy authorities.
