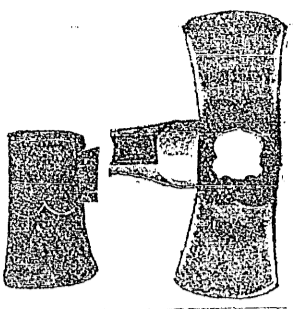

LACK OF HOMES FOR WORKERS SLOWS SHIPBUILDING

Practical Shipping Man Tells Senate Committee That Housing Problem Will Affect Results for 1918.

WASHINGTON, Wednesday, Jan. 9.—America's probable output of merchant ships in 1918 was put at 2,000,000 tons yesterday by Homer L. Ferguson, president and general manager of the Newport News Shipbuilding Company, testifying at the Senate shipbuilding inquiry. Ferguson, speaking by mail, said that 5,000,000 to 8,000,000 tons, he declared, were misleading to the public and should not be permitted to go unqualified.
