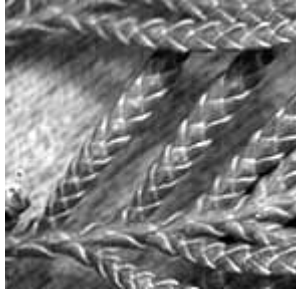
Western Red Cedar

Needles are scaly and grow close to the stem



Western Hemlock

Needles grow on either side of the stem



Douglas Fir

Needles grow all around the stem

Western Red Cedar

Bark is stringy and soft and can be easily peeled



Western Hemlock

Bark is thin and looks like puzzle-pieces



Douglas Fir

Bark is rough and thick

Western Red Cedar

Cones are extra small and look like tiny roses



Western Hemlock

Cones are small and look like fancy skirts



Douglas Fir

Cones are medium sized, hang down from the tree and tapered (come to a point)
