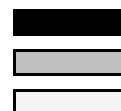

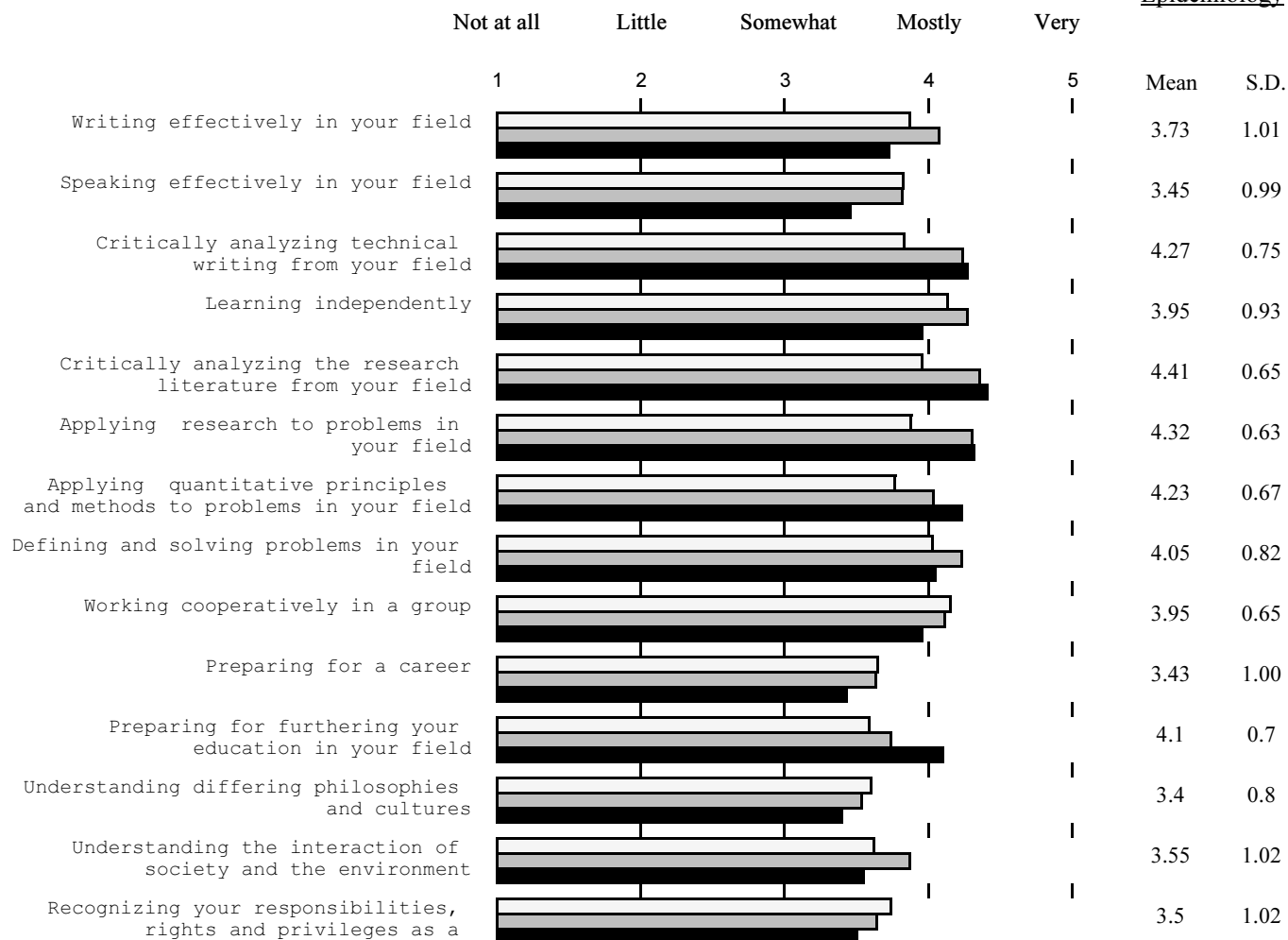

How satisfied are you with the University of Washington's contribution to your professional and academic growth in each of the following areas?

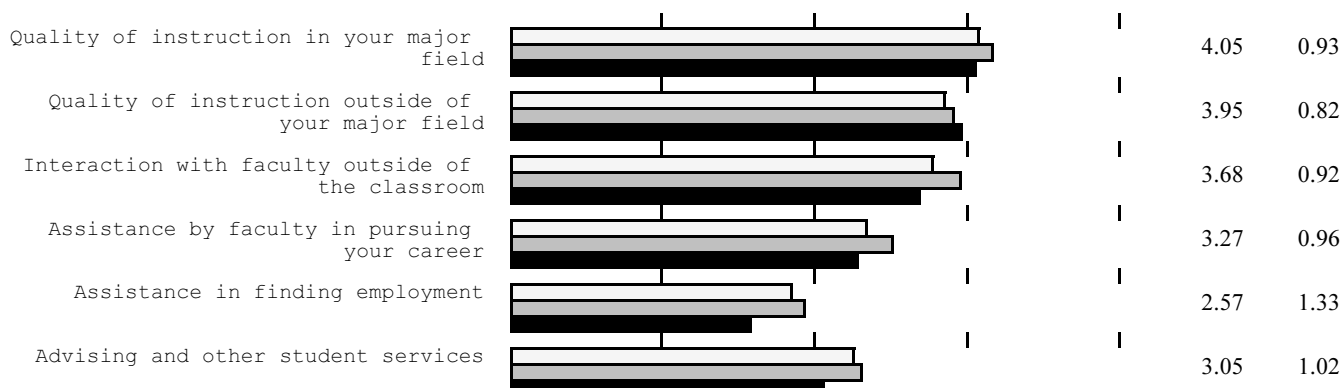

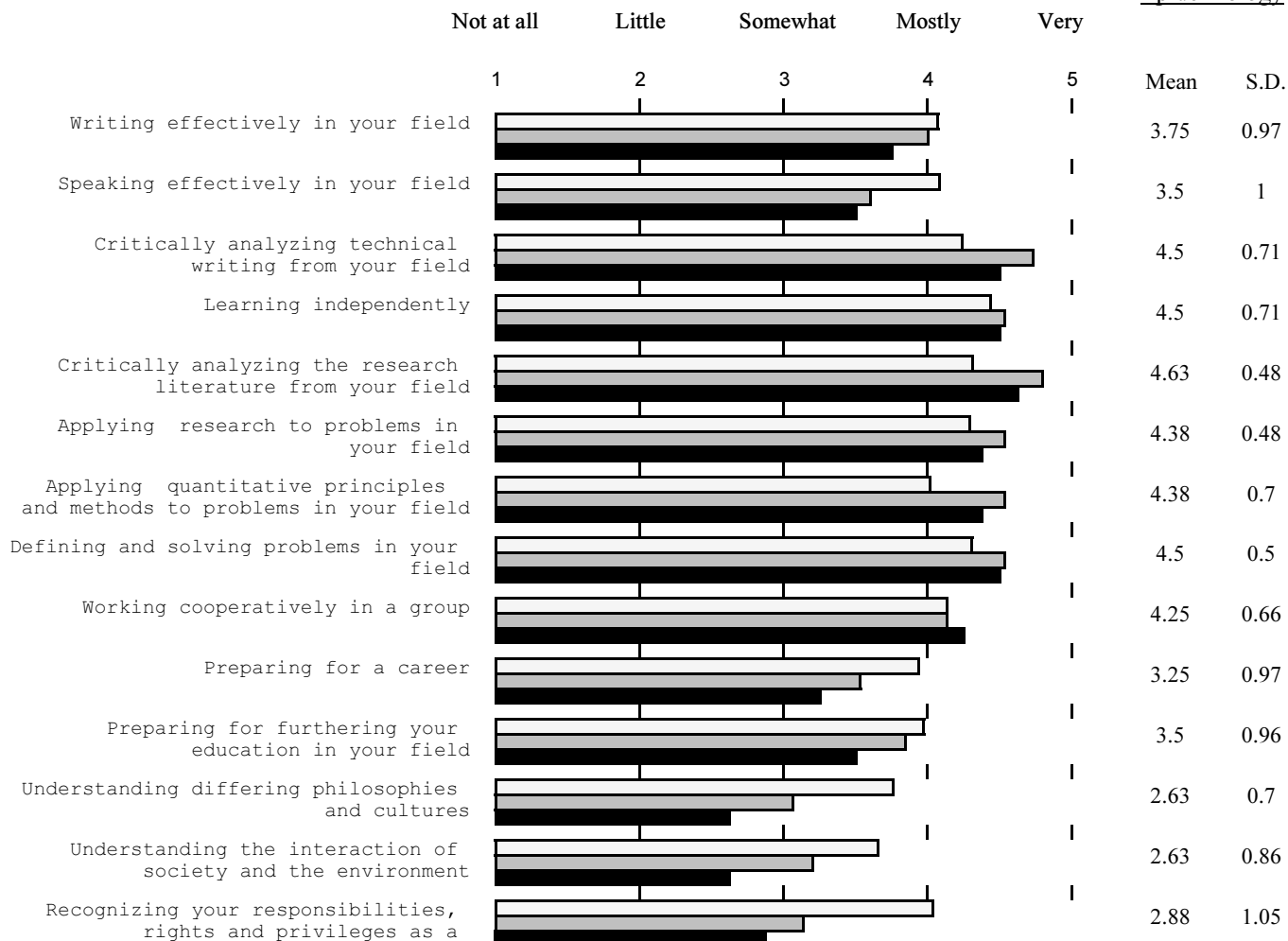

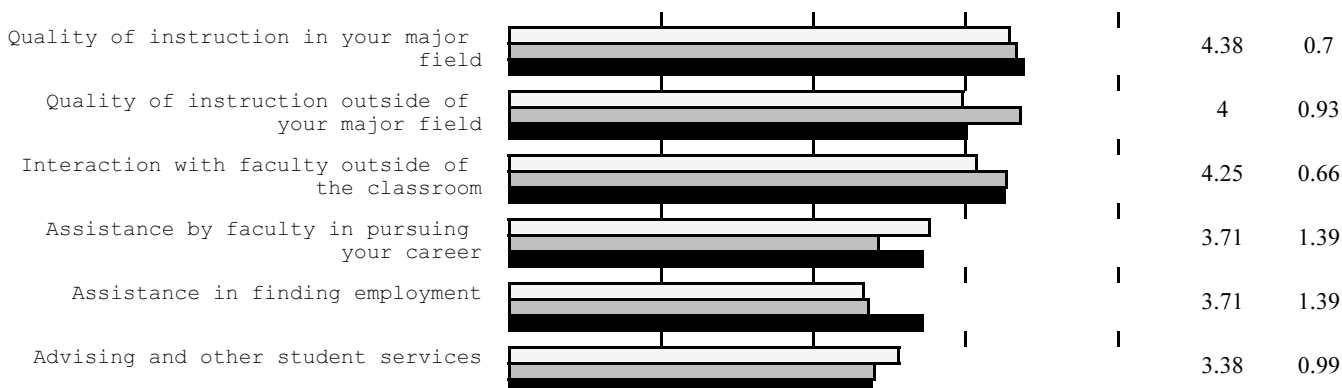
