The International Clinical Research Center Specimen and Data Repository

- <u>Description</u>: Samples from two HIV-prevention clinical trials, and an observational study all conducted in Africa
 - > ~2 million aliquots housed in Seattle
 - ➤ East & southern African HIV-1 serodifferent heterosexual couples (~8000 couples)
 - > 12-36 months follow-up and ~300 HIV-1 seroconversion events
 - > Participants consented for samples to be used in future studies of HIV, HIV-associated infections, and STIs
 - ➤ No linkage to personal identifiers
- Specimen Types: Serum, plasma, whole blood & blood spots, cryopreserved PBMCs, genital swabs/secretions, ...
- Data available:
 - Demographics
 - > Longitudinal clinical (e.g., plasma VL); behavioral (e.g., sex freq, condom use)
 - ➤ Laboratory data from subsets of participants: HLA, plasma viral genome sequence, host genotype, female reproductive contraceptive hormone levels
- <u>Charges</u>: If grant funding is available data management and specimen accession fees will be assessed

 If grant funding is unavailable waiver of charges will be considered
