TO HAVE AND TO HOLD The said premises, with their appurtenancés, unto the said part ies of the second part. their heirs and assigns, forever, and we the said parties of the first part do -- hereby covenant to and with the said part ies of the second part, their heirs and assigns, that we are the owner B in fee simple of said premises, that they are free from all incumbrances
