DESCRIPTION

BEGINNING AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF BLOCK 27, PERCIVAL'S SECOND ADDITION TO OLYMPIA, RUNNING THENCE NORTH 88° 36' 32" WEST ALONG THE SOUTH SIDE OF FOURTH AVE. W. 257.78 FEET TO A CONCRETE MONUMENT; THENCE SOUTH 19° 23' 28" WEST, 260.00 FEET TO A CONCRETE MONUMENT; THENCE NORTH 88° 36' 32" WEST, 79.35 FEET MORE OR LESS, TO A CONCRETE MONUMENT ON THE ORIGINAL WEST CITY LIMITS LINE OF THE CITY OF OLYMPIA; THENCE SOUTH 0° 27' 14" WEST ALONG SAID ORIGINAL WEST CITY LIMITS LINE, 137.58 FEET TO A CONCRETE MONUMENT, THE WEST ONE-SIXTEENTH CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 15 AND 22, TOWNSHIP 18 N., RANGE 2 W. OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN; THENCE SOUTH 89° 44' 19" EAST ALONG THE SECTION LINE BETWEEN SAID SECTIONS 15 AND 22, 230.41 FEET; THENCE NORTH 52° 22' 31" EAST ALONG THE WESTERLY MARGIN OF BLACK LAKE WAY 40.65 FEET TO A CONCRETE MONUMENT, WHICH MONUMENT IS 3000 FEET NORTH OF THE ESTABLISHED CENTER LINE OF NINTH AVE. W.; THENCE CONTINUING NORTH 52° 22' 31" EAST, 68.45 FEET TO A CONCRETE MONUMENT MARKING THE INTERSECTION OF THE WESTERLY MARGIN OF BLACK LAKE WAY AND THE WEST LINE OF PERCIVAL'S SECOND ADDITION PRODUCED; THENCE NORTH 1° 22' 12" EAST ALONG THE WEST LINE OF SAID PERCIVAL'S SECOND ADDITION, 1562.17 FEET MORE OR LESS, TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING; ALL OF WHICH IS A PART OF THE S.W. PERCIVAL DONATION CLAIM NO. 55, IN SECTION 15, TOWNSHIP 18 NORTH, RANGE 2 WEST OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN IN THE COUNTY OF THURSTON AND STATE OF WASHINGTON.

# WARRANTY DEED

The grantors, Charles J. Norton and Edna H. Norton, husband and wife, of the city of Olympia, county of Thurston, state of Washington, for and in consideration of

Ten & no/100 (\$ 10.00 ) dollars,  
in hand paid, convey and warrant to **Otto Rietdorf and Verline Rietdorf, husband and wife,**  
the following described real estate, situate in the county of Thurston, state of Washington:

Lot 3, & So<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> of Lot 2 Block 5 in Norton's Addition to Olympia, Washington, as shown on the plat of said addition recorded in volume 11 of plats, page 48, Records of Thurston County, subject to the rights granted the public in the dedication of said plat and the herein covenants and restrictions.

These covenants are to run with the land and shall be binding on all parties and all persons claiming under them until April 1st, 1970, at which time said covenants shall be automatically extended for successive periods of 10 years unless by vote of a majority of the then owners of the lots, it is agreed to change said covenants in whole or part.

A. All lots in the tract shall be known and described as residential lots. No structures shall be erected, altered, placed, or permitted to remain on any residential building plot other than one detached single-family dwelling not to exceed two and one-half stories in height and a private garage for not more than 2 cars and other outbuildings incidental to residential use of the plot.

B. No trailer, basement, tent, shack, garage, barn or other outbuilding erected in the tract shall at any time be used as a residence, temporarily or permanently, nor shall any structure of a temporary character be used as a residence.

C. No dwelling costing less than \$4000.00 shall be permitted on any lot in the tract. The ground floor area of the main structure, exclusive of one-story open porches and garages, shall not be less than 800 square feet in the case of a one-story structure nor less than 700 square feet in the case of a one and one-half, two, or two and one-half story structure.

D. That said premises shall never be used or occupied by any Negro, Mulatto, Indian, Chinese, Japanese, or person of the so-called black, brown, or yellow race, except that this covenant shall not prevent occupancy by domestic servants of a different race domiciled with an owner or tenant.

E. That any dwelling or structure erected or placed on any lot in this subdivision shall be completed as to external appearance including finished painting within 6 months from date of commencement of construction and shall be connected to septic tank or public sewerage.

Subject to assessments for sewer under Ordinance No. 2756,

District no. 571, which the grantees assume and agree to pay.
