Stewardship of Washington's Complex Transportation System

According to the latest U.S. Census (2016), Seattle was the fastest growing city in the U.S., with a net gain of nearly 21,000 people or 57 per day, on average. With that came an increase in vehicular traffic, which earned Seattle the ranking of 4th among U.S. cities for overall congestion levels.

Still, Seattle is only one piece of the puzzle in Washington, which has a large and complex transportation system, with many competing needs and limited resources. Under State leadership, numerous agencies and organizations are partnering to develop a regional strategy.
