NO STRUCTURE SHALL BE ERECTED, ALTERED, PLACED OR PERMITTED TO REMAIN ON ANY RESIDENTIAL PLOT OTHER THAN ONE DETACHED SINGLE FAMILY DWELLING NOT TO EXCEED 2 1/2 STORIES IN HEIGHT AND A PRIVATE GARAGE FOR NOT MORE THAN 2 CARS.

- NO BUILDING SHALL BE LOCATED NEARER THAN 20 FEET TO THE FRONT LOT LINE NOR NEARER THAN 8 FEET TO ANY SIDE STREET LINE. NO BUILDING, EXCEPT A DETACHED GARAGE OR OTHER OUTBWILDING LOCATED 75 FEET OR MORE FROM THE FRONT LOT LINE, SHALL BE LOCATED NEARER THAN 5 FEET TO ANY SIDE LOT
- NO RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURE" SHALL BE ERECTED OR PLACED ON ANY BUILDING PLOT, WHICH PLOT HAS AN AREA OF LESS THAN 5000 SQUARE FEET OR A WIDTH OF LESS THAN 50 FEET AT THE FRONT BUILDING SETBACK LINE.
- NO NOXIOUS OR OFFENSIVE TRADE OR ACTIVITY SHALL BE CARRIED ON UPON ANY LOT NOR SHALL ANYTHING BE DONE THEREON WHICH MAY BE OK BECOME AN ANNOYANCE OR NUISANCE TO THE NEIGHBORHOOD.
- NO TRAILER, BASEMENT, TENT. SHACK, GARAGE, BARN OR OTHER OUTBUILDING ERECTED IN THE TRACT SHALL AT ANY TIME BE USED AS A RESIDENCE TEMPORARILY NOR SHALL ANY STRUCTURE OF A TEMPORARY CHARACTER BE USED AS A RESIDENCE.
- NO PERSONS OF ANY RACE OTHER THAN THE WHITE OR CAUCASIAN RACE SHALL USE OR OCCUPY ANY BUILDING OR ANY LOT, EXCEPT THAT THESE COVENANTS SHALL NOT PREVENT OCCUPANCY BY DOMESTIC SERVANTS OF A DIFFERENT RACE DOMICILED WITH AN OWNER OR TENANT.
- THAT ANY DWELLING OR STRUCTURE ERECTED OR PLACED ON ANY LOT IN THE SUBDIVISION SHALL BE COMPLETED AS TO EXTERNAL APPEARANCE INCLUDING FINISHED PAINTING WITHIN 6 MONTHS FROM DATE OF COMENCEMENT OF CONSTRUCTION AND SHALL BE CONNECTED TO APPROVED SEPTIC T. NK OR PUBLIC SEWER.

NANTS For amended Pratective Coverante See Fee # 1434061, V. 13, Page 85

These coverants are to run with the land and shall be binding on all parties and persons claiming over them until January 1st, 1962 at which times said Coverants shall be automatically extended for encessive periods of Dycars unless by vote of the majority of the then owners of the Ints it is agreed to change said Loverants in whole or in part.

lavalidation of any one of these coverants by judgement or court order shall be in no wise effect and of the provisions which shall remain in full force and effect.

A. All lots in the tract shall be described as residential lots, except lots I to 21 inclusive, Block 2 which may be described as either residential or business lots.

No structure shall be erected, altered, placed or permitted to remain on any residential plot other than one detached single family dwelling not to exceed 2% stories in height and a private garage for not more than 2 cars.

13. No building skall be located nearer than 20 feet to the Located line nor nearer than 3 feet to any side street line. No building except a delacked datage or other outbuilding located 75 feet or more from the front lot line, skall be located nearer than 5 feet in any side let line.

6. No residential structure shall be erected or placed on any building plot, which plot has an trea of less than 5000 square feet or a width of less than 50 feet at the front building setback line.

D. No noxious or of ferance trade or activity shall be carried on upon any lot nor shall anything be done thereon which may be or become an annoyance or nuisance to the neighborhood.

Ho trailer, basement tent, shack, darage, barn or other outbuilding erected in the tract shall at any time be used as a residence temporarity or permanently, nor shall any structure of a temporary character be used as a residence.

to persons of any race other than the White or Caucasian race shall use or occupy any building or any lot, except that this Lovenant shall not prevent occupancy by domestic servants of a different race domiciled with an owner or tenant.

That any dwelling or structure erected or placed on any lot in the subdivision shall be completed as to external appearance including finished painting within 6 months from date of commencement of construction and shall be connected to approved septe tank or public sewer.
