(CORPORATE FORM)

Lot Twenty-five (25), Block One (1), Mountain View Addition to the City of Olympia, subject to the following restrictions:

It is mutually understood, and agreed that the grant hereby made is subject to the following real covenants running with the Lot to-wit:

- 1. No dwelling shall be erected on this property which shall have a value of less than \$2000 in normal times.
- 2. That said premises shall never be sold, leased, or rented to any Negro, Mulatto, Indian, Chinaman, Japanese, or person of the so-called Black, Brown, or Yellow races.
- 3. No dwelling shall be constructed within thirty'(30) feet of the East line of said Lot.

The Grantor, for itself and for its successors and assigns does by these presents expressly limit the covenants of this deed to those herein expressed, and excludes all covenants arising or to arise by statutory or other implication, and does hereby covenant that against all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim by, through or under said Grantor and not otherwise, it will forever warrant and defend the said described real estate.
