# FAMILY MEDICINE SUB-INTERNSHIP Grading Criteria 2012-13

## **Grading Criteria**

#### 1. Honors

Students must receive at least nine scores of 5 and no score less than a 4 in any category for Honors. if a preceptor does not have sufficient contact to judge procedural skills resulting in "N/A" score in this category, the student must receive at least eight scores of 5 and no score less than a 4 in any category for Honors.

# 2. High Pass

Students must receive at least nine scores of 4 and no score less than a 3 in any category for High pass. if a preceptor does not have sufficient contact to judge procedural skills resulting in "N/A" score in this category, the student must receive at least eight scores of 4 and no score less than a 3 in any category for Honors.

### 3. Pass

The Pass grade reflects the performance of a student at the expected level for a third year clerkship student.

#### 4. Fail

A failing grade is based on student's performance taken as a whole and not solely based on any one numeric profile. A 1 in any category will result in a failure. Multiple 2's may result in a failure.

### **Overall Assessment of Professionalism**

Assessment of student professionalism is based on the "Interpersonal Relationships" and "Personal Characteristics" categories of the evaluation form.

1. **Meets or Exceeds Expectations**: 3 or above in ALL categories

2. **Below Expectations**: 2 in any category

3. Unacceptable: 1 in any category
