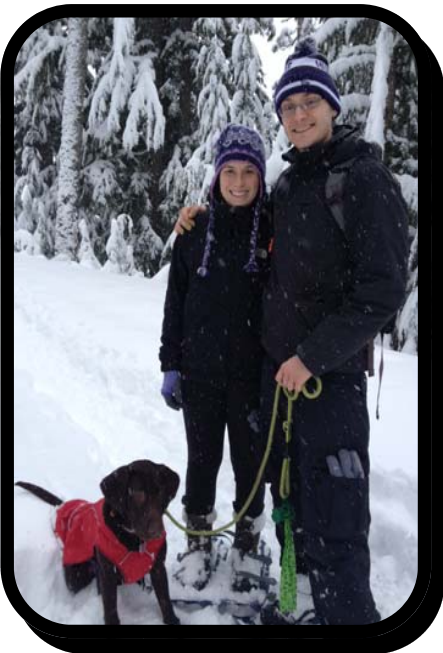


Hello Newport!

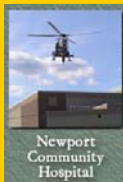
