About the Hospital:

Quincy Valley Medical Center is a rural hospital with a rural health clinic (RHC) attached. QVMC is a designated Critical Access Hospital. The Hospital serves a growing population and is centrally located directly between Seattle and Spokane 10 miles north of I-90. The organization is also planning replacement of the Hospital facilities and is evolving to meet the growing needs of the community. The Hospital is directed by expert executive leadership and a 5 member, Board of Commissioners. This leadership team has helped the Hospital realize recent financial growth with volume increases the past three years. The Hospital currently employs approximately 108 individuals.

About the Position:

The Hospital is currently recruiting for a committed Physician (MD or DO) for the SageView Family Care Clinic that is under the umbrella of the Hospital. The ideal Physician practices and promotes a continuum of care from preventive to acute care management. QVMC seeks a collaborative leader who understands healing systems. This is a lifestyle group with moderate hospital admissions call, (1:5). In addition to family practice services, Quincy Valley Medical Center offers specialized programs including physical therapy, massage therapy, nutrition counseling, podiatry and osteoporosis testing programs.

The clinic is currently comprised of one employed female Nurse Practitioner and one locum MD, in addition to a professional and stable support team. The clinic currently has a volume of 500-600 patients per month. The clinic offers same day appointments, a busy practice while still allowing quality time per patient and an opportunity to serve a diverse patient population.

The clinic operates Monday through Friday and the current hours are 8:00 to 5:30. The on-call schedule for Hospital acute care admissions would be 1:5, most often the provider would not be required to come to the Hospital, but would complete the required paperwork the following morning of the admissions.

Preferred Experience:

- Ideal candidates will be certified in family practice and would see all ages with no restrictions
- Knowledge base experience of complimentary healthcare
- 3 years of practice experience is preferred; **NEW GRAD ACCEPTABLE**
- Candidates must have a commitment to working in an interdisciplinary team of physicians and allied health professionals.
- MD able to support and cultivate the commitment to a multidisciplinary and patient-centered care model.
- Fluency in medical Spanish is highly desirable
- Experience with hospital acute care admissions is preferred

Requirements:

- Possess and maintain a current, unrestricted license to practice medicine in the State of Washington
- Board Certification in Family Practice, or Board Eligible
- Current certification in ACLS, BLS, and PALS preferred

Community Overview:

Quincy is located near the center of Washington State, 30 miles East of Wenatchee. The City of Quincy has a population of 7,000 with a service area of approximately 13,000. City facilities include a Library, Aquatic Center, six parks with picnic sites and a museum.

Quincy is the gateway to the Wenatchee Valley, Leavenworth and the Okanogan Valley. The area is one of the sunniest places in Washington and a common weekend getaway for those living in the Puget Sound area.

Downtown Seattle is a gorgeous and relaxing drive just 150 miles from Quincy. Spokane is just a two hour drive.
