## 1 Title: RESOLUTION URGING THE UNIVERSITY OF WASHINGTON TO ADOPT AN 2 OPEN ACCESS PUBLICATIONS POLICY 3 4 Sponsored by: Juliya Ziskina, Eddie Schwieterman 5 Written by: Juliya Ziskina, Austin Wright-Pettibone, Tim Jewell, Mel DeSart 6 7 Resolution Number: 1.14-15 8 9 WHEREAS the primary mission of the University of Washington is the advancement, 10 dissemination, and preservation of knowledge; and 11 12 WHEREAS the current system for production and distribution of scholarly works is increasingly 13 unsustainable and restricts rather than increases access to and dissemination of research 14 conducted at the University of Washington; and 15 16 WHEREAS open access to scholarly work generated at the University of Washington will 17 contribute to the advancement of the University's primary mission as well as increase the public 18 visibility and scholarly impact of the University's researchers, 19 20 THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GRADUATE AND PROFESSIONAL STUDENT 21 SENATE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF WASHINGTON: 22 23 THAT the GPSS calls upon the faculty of the University of Washington to adopt an open access 24 publications policy that encourages free and public access to the scholarly peer reviewed articles 25 produced by University of Washington students, staff, and faculty; and 26 27 THAT University of Washington students, staff, and faculty provide to the appropriate party of 28 the University, no later than date of publication, an electronic copy of the author's final version 29 to be deposited in an open access repository; and 30 31 THAT this policy applies to all scholarly peer-reviewed articles authored or co-authored by 32 current UW students, staff, or faculty, except for any articles published before the adoption of 33 this policy, as well as any articles for which the student, staff, or faculty member has entered into 34 an incompatible licensing or assignment agreement before the adoption of said policy; and 35 36 THAT the University of Washington waives application of this policy for a particular article 37 upon written notification by an author or co-author; and 38 39 THAT this policy does not in any way prescribe or limit the venue of publication; and 40 41 THAT the University of Washington encourages and supports student, staff, and faculty 42 publication in open access journals; and 43

44 THAT the University of Washington Libraries provide relevant, current information regarding 45 journal publishers, pricing, and authors' rights to departments and individual faculty members; 46 and 47 48 THAT the University of Washington continuously evaluates its open access publications policy 49 to ensure that such a policy is most effective at facilitating public access to scholarly peer-50 reviewed articles produced by University of Washington students, staff, and faculty; and 51 52 THAT the University of Washington administration provide sufficient resources to the libraries 53 and to academic units to better foster these efforts; and 54 55 THAT the GPSS calls upon the Student Senate of the ASUW and the Faculty Senate of the 56 University of Washington to adopt similar resolutions in support of a robust and clearly defined 57 open access policy; and 58 59 THAT a copy of this resolution be forwarded to GPSS President Alice Popejoy, ASUW 60 President Christina Xiao, Faculty Senate Chair Kate O'Neill, Interim Director of Information 61 Resources and Scholarly Communication Gordon Aamot, and Vice Provost for Digital Initiatives 62 and Dean of University Libraries Betsy Wilson. 63 64 Presented to GPSS for approval on Wednesday, January 14, 2015. 65 Approved on January 14, 2015
