





Highlights from January Board of Regents meeting

- 1. GS Dean David Eaton, & Dean of SoM & SoL presented last 5 yrs' application and enrollment data (residency, program types, racial groups, ethnicity): check item A2
- Master's students represent **65**% of total graduate enrollment; Ph.D. students do **35**%.
- **53.4**% of all master's enrollment is currently in fee-based programs.
- International graduate students now account for **21.1**% of total graduate enrollment.
- Underrepresented minority students' application and enrollment number have grown over the last 5 years.
