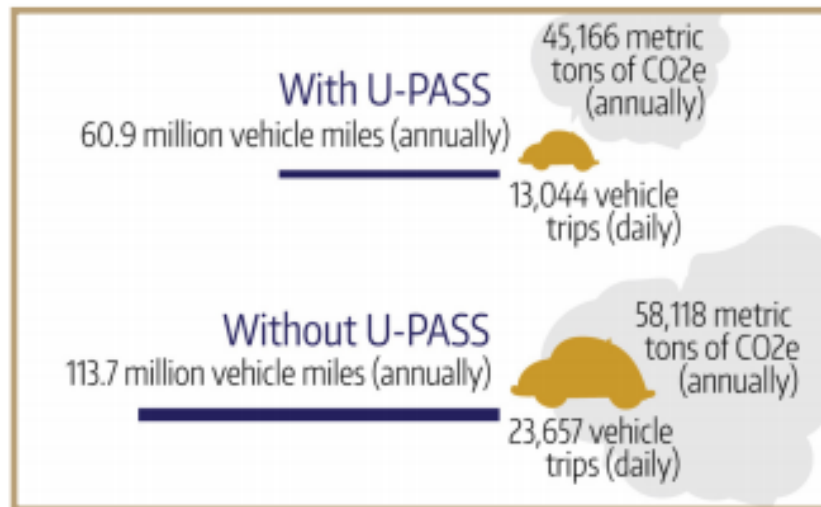

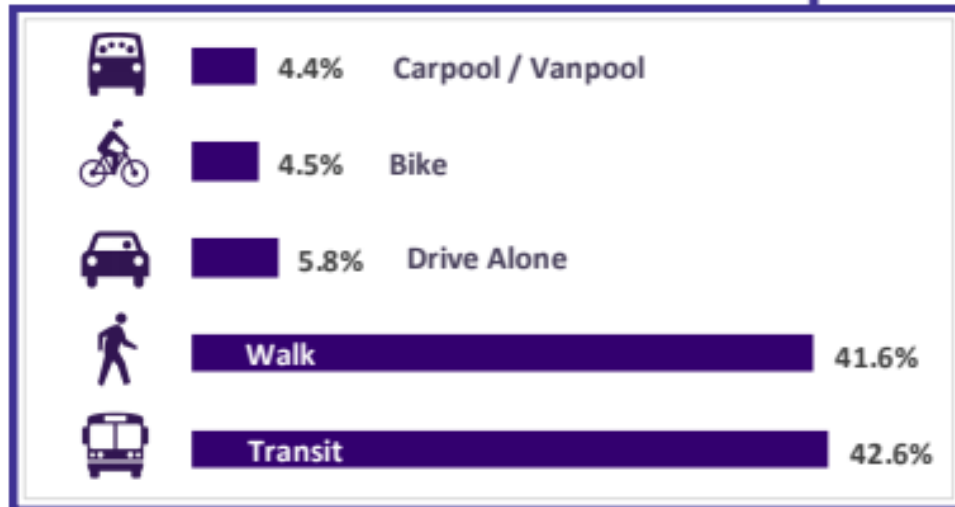

(FY18 PROJECTIONS)

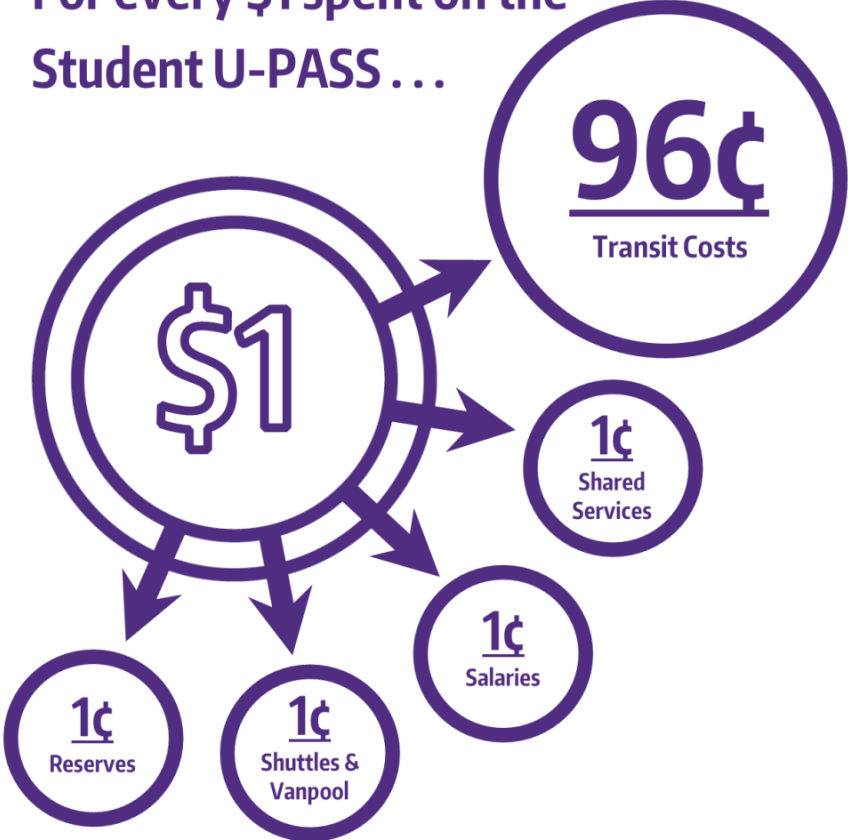

Reserves**

By law, the U-PASS is not permitted to operate at a deficit. Any revenue collected in excess of program costs goes into the U-PASS reserves. Reserves help defray future cost increases and ultimately go back into the program.
