Title IX Changes: Update

Major Takeaways

- New federal regulations set to go into effect August 14, 2020
 - apply to higher education institutions and K-12 schools that receive federal financial assistance
- Maintained most provisions from proposed regulations:
 - narrows scope of what can be defined as sexual misconduct under Title IX
 - no longer requires coaches, educators, and other employees to report allegations of sexual misconduct
 - institutions must hold live hearings with an opportunity for cross-examination
 - Some protections in place to shield survivors from answering questions posed by the accused or seeing/interacting with the accused
 - institutions must provide the parties with access to information collected during the investigation prior to determination of responsibility

Major Takeaways

- Things that have changed:
 - Holds colleges responsible for off-campus sexual harassment at “a building owned or controlled by a student organization that is officially recognized by a postsecondary institution” or at locations where a school has “substantial control” over students
 - This appears to include academic conferences
- UW response:
 - Office of Title IX currently going through full language of regulations
 - “changes do not diminish our shared responsibility to create a culture that does not tolerate sexual assault, harassment or misconduct.”

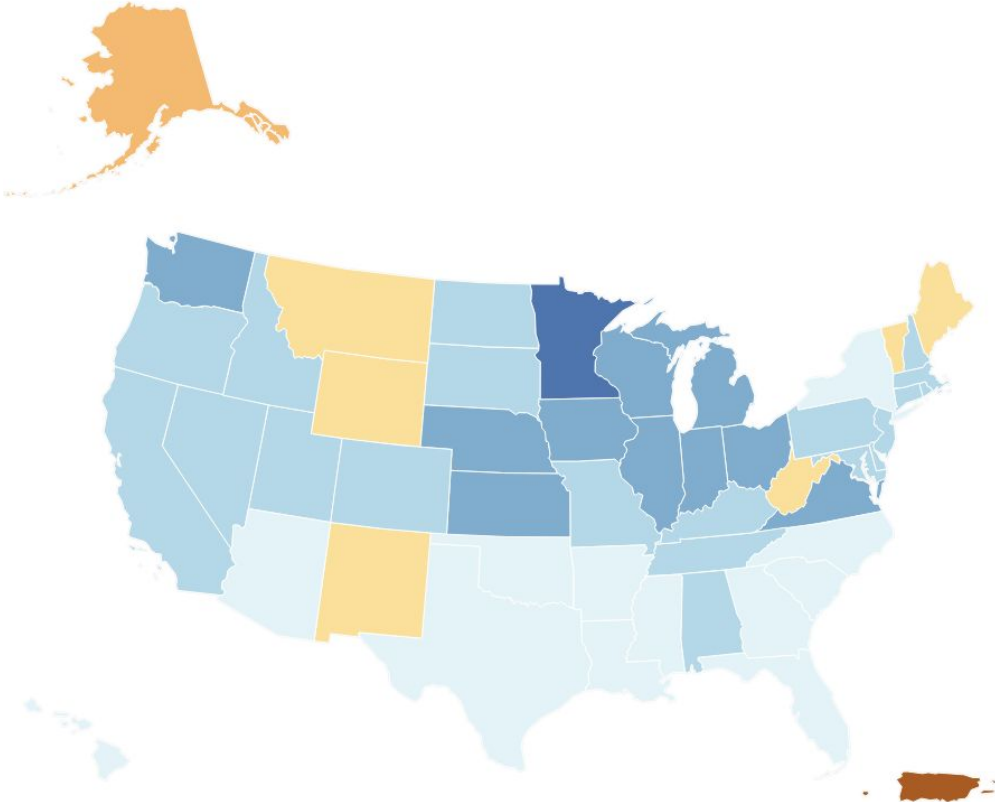

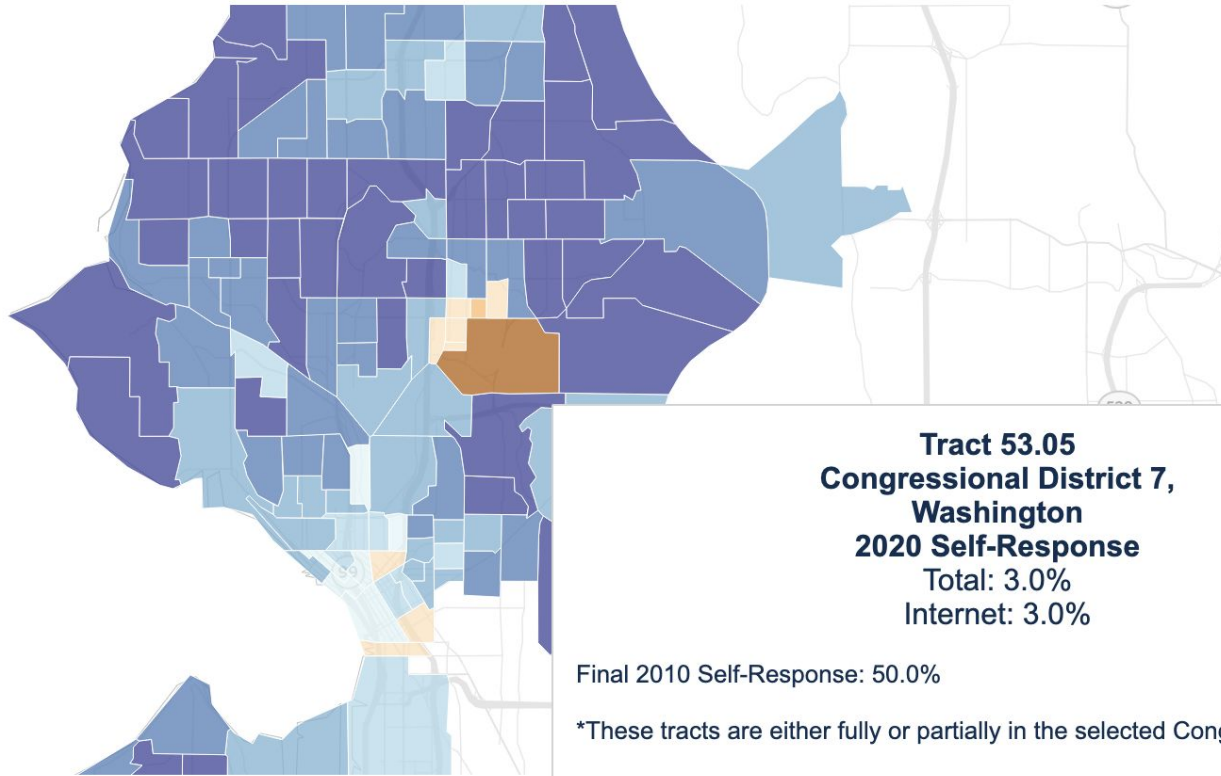
UW Response (data from May 13th;12pm)
