

## **GPSS Vice President of Administration Quarterly Report: Winter 2023**

## **GPSS Administrative Work**

- Oversaw and maintained GPSS records, including the Senate email list, Executive Committee email lists, Rosters, Senate Website, and Minutes
- Ongoing communication with 14 departments across campus regarding the possibilities of recruitment and GPSS representation
- Administered and caried out the GPSS Attendance policy for Winter 2023
- Prepared and provided necessary research to maintain organizational compliance with GPSS Bylaws, suggesting consideration, revision, or suspension when necessary
- Consulted and offered both substantive and administrative feedback for multiple Resolution drafts, including the Ad Hoc Committee Student Health Advocacy Resolution Panel (SHARP) proposed joint resolution on sharps containers and a Wellness Day Resolution being proposed in Spring 2023
- Organized and provided initial materials to the elections and judicial committees for Winter quarter start-up
- Assisted the President in revitalizing the Senator of the Month Program, administered nominations, and provided primary authorship of the proclamations
- Assisted the President and Office Director in organizing GPSS Spotlights for the GPSS Website
- Completed Staff evaluations for GPSS Staff members in the Office of Administration

## **GPSS Meetings, Committees, and Events**

- Primary creator for GPSS Meeting materials, including Agendas, PowerPoint presentations, ballots, QR codes, votes, and Website entries to facilitate Senate proceedings
- Reviewed and administered parliamentary procedure at meetings, including timekeeping, motions regarding compliance with the bylaws, and enforcement of procedures for informed, fair, and equitable participation
- Reviewed all GPSS Senate and Executive Committee Meeting Minutes as prepared and submitted by the GPSS Senate Director
- Provided initial organization for the Arts Council (though this committee was unable to meet this Quarter due to member availability)
- Served on the Marsha Landolt Distinguished Graduate Mentor Award Selection Committee, reviewing approximately 400 pages of materials and meeting to select the Award recipient
- Acting as Supervising Officer of the Ad Hoc Committee for Senators Motivation and Recruitment/Retention (CSMR), including consultation for its policy memo
