As you know the library was funded entirely by my husband Tim and myself as well as the endowment father librarians.

are "top of the line" and we are forming a lending library division as well as children's books (at no cost to the general public).

As you know, we have received national and international recognition from the Council of Botanical and Botanical Libraries which have chosen our library for their Annual Meeting in May 1938.

But now, we have had unforeseen costs during 1932 and I have recently contributed \$10,000 to pull us through.

Because we also need to continually grow to maintain our standards, we will be starting our first educational effort by a committee to be called "The Library Guardians":
