WHAT IS CERVICAL CANCER?

CERVICAL CANCER is a type of cancer that occurs in the cells of the cervix (lower part of the uterus that connects to the vagina) caused by human papillomavirus.

• More than 4,800 women are diagnosed with cervical cancer in Kenya annually

- About 2,500 cervical cancer deaths occur annually in Kenya
- It is the second most common cancer after breast cancer worldwide
- It is 6 times more prevalent in Kenya than in Europe and North America
- Early stages of cervical cancer show no symptoms
- It is preventable by HPV vaccination



WHAT IS **KEN SHE** STUDY

• KENya Single-dose HPV-vaccine Efficacy Study will test the efficacy of single dose for young women in prevention of Cervical cancer.

- It is a multi site study being conducted in Kisumu, Thika and Nairobi.
- The young women will be followed up for a period of 36 months.
