The Dementia with Lewy Bodies Consortium



Eligibility Criteria

Patients may qualify for this study if they meet the requirements:

- Have a diagnosis of probable dementia with Lewy bodies, dementia with Lewy body/MCI, or Parkinson's disease dementia
- Have a study partner who is able and willing to comply with required study procedures
- Have at least eight years of education

The study doctor will also check for other medical conditions or reasons that might prevent you from participating in the study.

Summary of Study

The purpose of the Dementia with Lewy Bodies
Consortium is to develop a collection of
samples from individuals diagnosed with
dementia with Lewy bodies (DLB), dementia
with Lewy bodies/MCI, or Parkinson's disease
dementia who will be followed over time. The
consortium will collect detailed clinical
information, biospecimens, and imaging data.
Led by top leaders in the field, this consortium
will fill the gap in resources available for
biomarker development in Lewy Body Dementia
and promote additional future research by
having a readily available subject sample.
