Spring 2023 Quarter

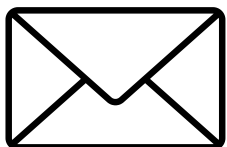
An mentorship opportunity to work with undergraduates to help improve their science literacy and presentation skills.
