

Parking Options near the Memory Hub (1021 Columbia St, Seattle WA 98104)

1. Street Parking, ADA Parking and Drop-Off Zones near the Memory Hub: (Blue Arrow on map)

There is some paid street parking available in the area. In addition, there are 3-min and 15-min load/unload zones directly in front of the Memory Hub. The Frye Art Museum has generously designated a 15-min load/unload space for the Memory Hub in the small lot adjacent to the Museum and the Memory Hub, as well as an ADA parking spot for visitors to either the Museum or the Memory Hub. These two spots are clearly marked with signage; please do not use other spots in this lot.

- From I-5 James St Exit, head uphill (east) on James St.
- Turn Left on Ninth Ave – begin looking for street parking as you continue along the route.
- Turn Right on Columbia St
- Pass Terry Ave. On this block, between Terry Ave and Boren, you'll typically have your best luck with street parking.
- The Memory Hub is on your Right, on this block. You will see the 3-min and 15-min load/unload zone on the street here, as well as the adjacent parking lot with the designated Memory Hub load/unload parking spot and ADA parking spot.

2. Valet Parking at Murano Senior Living (Complementary, Limited): (Orange Arrow on map)

Murano Senior Living (620 Terry Ave) has graciously provided a limited number of parking spaces to Memory Hub visitors, free of charge. Valet parking is included, and your parking ticket must be validated with a sticker at the Memory Hub in order to receive complementary parking. It is best to be facing north at the valet drop-off, which requires taking a loop around the building – simply follow the instructions below. From drop-off, the Memory Hub is 3 level blocks away.


- From I-5 James St Exit, head uphill (east) on James St.
- Turn Left on Ninth Ave. You will be making a loop around the Murano so that you end up facing north outside of their valet parking area.
- Turn Right on Cherry St.
- Turn Right on Boren Ave.
- Turn Right on James St.
- Turn Right on Terry Ave.
- Pull up in front of Murano Senior Living (620 Terry Ave) and wait for the valet. The valet may not be at the curb right away if they are assisting another guest. Tell the valet that you are visiting the Memory Hub, give them your keys, and receive a parking ticket from them. Again, please be sure to validate this parking ticket when you are at the Memory Hub in order to receive complementary parking.

3. Paid Parking at Ninth & Jefferson Building, Harborview: (Green Arrow on map)

The Ninth & Jefferson Building Parking (or "P-3" Parking) is an underground parking lot on Harborview Campus. The charge is \$5 for up to 2 hours. The address of the Ninth & Jefferson Building is 908 Jefferson St, and the parking lot entrance is accessed on the back side of the building, on Terry Avenue between James and Jefferson St. From the lobby of the building, the Memory Hub is about 5 level blocks away.

- From I-5 James St Exit, head uphill (east) on James St.
- Turn Right on Terry Ave, then turn Right into the parking lot entrance
- After parking, take the elevator up to the lobby and exit to Ninth Ave.
