The MEDEX Physician Assistant Program at the University of Washington Spokane training site (Gonzaga University campus) seeks to hire a full-time didactic and clinical faculty member. Primary didactic faculty responsibilities include developing and delivering lectures, chairing or co-chairing one or more courses, and advising/evaluating students. Clinical faculty responsibilities include clinical rotation development maintaining relationships with our clinical partners, managing student placements during the second (clinical) year, developing and maintaining the clinical year curriculum, and supervising end-of-rotation activities. Faculty participate in admissions activities, scholarly activity as well as other duties as assigned. The didactic and clinical roles may be combined in a full-time position.

This position is a non-tenure track appointment, renewable annually, at the faculty rank of Lecturer or Senior Lecturer, depending on experience and qualifications. Faculty members enjoy a generous benefits package. The University of Washington faculty engages in teaching, research, and service.

Requirements:

- A Bachelor's degree
- Willing to pursue or already hold a Master's degree
- Current NCCPA certification or equivalent and two years of clinical experience
- Proficient email communication skills and a willingness to travel extensively within the WWAMI region (Eastern Washington, Idaho and Montana) to maintain and/or develop clinical rotation sites
