- **Hybrid course.** Class content is delivered via a combination of live online Zoom session(s) and a self-paced online learning course.
- Classroom session. Class content is delivered in-person at University District Station Building (UDSB) at 4328 Brooklyn Ave. NE. Participations receive supplemental materials such as a book or printed workbook and/or access to online materials.
- **Mixed format.** Class content is delivered through a combination of two or more of the above formats.
