Some **common and important issues**:

- 1. If you are interested in **Child and Adolescent Psychiatry**, please remember that you need to apply formally to the Child and Adolescent Psychiatry Program through the Match in the summer prior to the July when you wish to start the child program. You can enter child as a PGY-4 or a PGY-5. You must apply through the Match for any child program you are interested in, including our own UW program. **Psychosomatic Medicine Fellowships** are also done through the match and are due in the summer early fall but you must be a PGY-4 to apply.
- 2. If you have not yet met the Board requirement for 2 months FTE of neurology, this requirement can be met through outpatient neurology clinic rotations at UWMC, Harborview, or the VA.

Although we will try to assign you to rotations and sites that you request, it may not be possible to give you all of your first choices. However, we will make every effort to be fair, so if you don't get your first choice now, you will receive your reward on another rotation selection or at some time in the future... If you did not receive your first choices in the past, please feel free to remind me of this! And please be sure to let me know which of your requests are most important to you!
