Seattle Children's Autism Center is leading a clinical investigational device trial in partnership with Marcus Autism Center to find better ways to diagnose and treat autism at an earlier age.

We're looking for typically developing toddlers, 16 to 30 months old, to participate in a three- to four-hour visit.

The clinical trial consists of:

- Playing games that test language, learning and social skills.
- Watching kid-friendly videos while we track eye movement.
- Meeting with a coordinator who will collect medical information like height and weight.

You will receive a written report about your child's development and compensation for your participation.
