Greetings Natacha,

I am writing to officially inform you of the allocation made to the Counseling Center for Fiscal Year 2026. After extensive deliberations, as well as consideration of your submitted documents and testimony, the Services & Activities Fee Committee agreed to recommend an allocation of \$2,561,889. The recommendation was accepted by the Vice President for Student Life, Denzil Suite, and was approved by the Board of Regents during their May 8th meeting.

This year, increases in requests were close to \$600k more than our projected increase in revenue. Despite this, after careful consideration of the increasing demand for the Counseling Center's services and labor costs, the Committee decided on an allocation representing a \$123,009 increase over Fiscal Year 2025, reflecting the Counseling Center's full request for Mandatory Wages and Benefits and the partial request for Market Wages.

The Committee appreciates your detailed explanation of your operations and use of SAF funds. We also applaud your commitment to using our logo on your website.

I understand that it can be disheartening to receive less than your full request, but we hope that your allocation allows you to continue serving students. We encourage you to continue looking for ways to increase your self-generated revenue.

The Committee thanks you for your cooperation with the SAF process, and we hope to continue working together in the future. It has been a pleasure working with you, and I wish you the best.
