Greetings GPSS,

I am writing to officially inform you of the allocation made to GPSS for Fiscal Year 2026. After extensive deliberations, as well as consideration of your submitted documents and testimony, the Services & Activities Fee Committee agreed to recommend an allocation of **\$548,351**. The recommendation was accepted by the Vice President for Student Life, Denzil Suite, and was approved by the Board of Regents during their May 8th meeting.

This year, total requested increases were close to \$600k more than our projected increase in revenue. Despite this, after careful consideration of the increased funding needs of GPSS the Committee decided on an allocation representing a \$26,552 increase over Fiscal Year 2025, reflecting the full GPSS request for Mandatory Wages and Benefits and the partial request for Programming.

I understand that it can be disheartening to receive less than your full request, but we hope that your allocation allows you to continue serving students. We invite you to explore options for additional revenue.

The Committee thanks you for your cooperation with the SAF process, and we hope to continue working together in the future. It has been a pleasure working with you, and I wish you the best.
