- Update your Profile (add languages) and Passport
- Update the Checklists starting with Novice Low and moving up
- 3. Add Evidence after you have checked a statement as "I can do this": (Note: Be sure you have updated "Can Do" for the CanDo statement first (then the Evidence column will show "0").)

For practice, try these:

- Novice Low, Presentational Writing: I can copy some characters and words.
  CanDo: I can label some familiar things.
  (Evidence: Type in a list of objects you see in the room around you)
- Novice Mid, Presentational Speaking: I can provide information about myself and my immediate surroundings using words, phrases, and memorized expressions.

**CanDo:** I can express my likes and dislikes using words, phrases, and memorized expressions.

(Evidence: Record which sports you like and dislike in simple words or phrases, e.g., *I like baseball. I don't like football. Etc....*)

 Novice High, Interpersonal Communication: I can exchange information about familiar tasks, topics, and activities.

**CanDo:** I can exchange information with other people about what to do, where to go, and when to meet.

(Evidence: Video a brief conversation where you invite and make plans with someone to do something or go somewhere.)
