- How do I maximize student learning through my instructional planning?
 - standards
 - backward design
 - meets all needs
 - student goal setting & self assessment
 - empower for life-long learning
 - engaging and contextualized

Keys to Planning for Learning

Mindset for Thematic Unit Design

Design units that are...

- Communicatively purposeful
- Culturally focused
- Intrinsically interesting
- Cognitively engaging
- Standards-based

Keys to Planning for Learning p. 26

(based on Helena Curtain's 3 principles for unit design)

Backward Design for Lesson Planning

- Identify desired results
 - Set clear learning objectives
- Determine acceptable evidence
 - How will learners demonstrate their progress on the objectives?
- Plan learning experiences and instruction

The Lesson Template

- Elements from the Unit Plan:
 - Language Level, Grade
 - Unit Theme and Question
 - Standards Lesson Objectives
- Lesson Sequence & Activities
- _{*} Time
- Materials * Resources * Technology

Lesson Sequence & Activities (Opening)

- Gain Attention/Activate Prior Knowledge
 - "Hook" the learner's attention
 - Engages each learner
 - Takes no more than 5 minutes
 - Connects with what will happen next

Lesson Sequence & Activities (Cycle 1)

Provide Input

- "What is the most important thing that I intend to do today to enhance learning?"
- Comprehensible input
- Authentic text
 - Learners do not need to understand everything
- Elicit Performance/Provide Feedback
 - Allow learners to apply what they are learning in meaningful ways

Lesson Sequence & Activities (Cycle 2)

- Provide Input
 - Time for direct instruction that connects to the objective of the lesson
- Elicit Performance/Provide Feedback
 - Learners apply what they've learned and receive feedback (again)

Lesson Sequence & Activities (Closure)

Assess Performance/Closure

 Use exit slips to see if daily objectives were met

Enhance Retention & Transfer

- Homework is an opportunity for formative assessment
- Avoid rote practice
- Use homework as a pre-learning activity (read about the topic in English)

Lesson Sequence & Activities (Reflection)

- Reflection Notes to Self
 - What worked well? Why?
 - What didn't? Why?
 - What changes would you make?



- Teacher Principal Evaluation Project
- Districts choose one of three frameworks
- Each teacher is evaluated based on this chosen framework
- Comprehensive all 8 criteria
- Focused I of 8 criteria



- 8 Criteria for teachers
- Centering instruction on high expectations
- Demonstrating effective teaching practices
- Individualizing instruction
- Demonstrating subject matter knowledge
- Fostering a safe, positive learning environment
- Using student data to modify instruction
- Communicating with parents and school community
- Exhibiting collaborative and collegial practices



- 4 Summative Evaluation Ratings
- Distinguished
- Proficient
- Basic
- Unsatisfactory
