

Final Grade Breakdown

The final clerkship grade consists of a clinical grade plus or minus a possible point adjustment based on the exam grade. The scores from the clinical evaluation in twelve indices, scored 1 – 4, will be averaged to calculate the clinical grade. Based on the student’s exam grade, +/- 0.20 points may be added/deducted to the clinical grade based on the table below. **There is a minimum exam score of 74 required to be Honors eligible.**

Failure to complete required clerkship assignments will result in a deduction of 0.05 **PER ASSIGNMENT**, to a maximum of 0.30 point, from your final grade.
