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To learn how children & teenagers with autism/ASD understand the meanings and associations of sights, sounds, and names of things in the world around us.

Who Can Participate?

6-17-year-old children with autism/ASD or typical development.

What will the study involve?

For children: psychological testing including IQ & vocabulary tests and other tests involving pictures, words, and sounds. For parents: phone call screening questions

How long will it take?

Two visits of about 2-3 hours each, plus phone calls at the start of the study.

What is the compensation?

\$50 gift certificate for study completion and reimbursement for parking for each visit.
